1917 –distinct rust resistant wheat variety named Axminister

1917 –won 1st for wheat at the World's Fair in Chicago Ill. Received Coronation Medal from King George



Dr. Grant MacEwan

1928 –Head of Animal Husbandry U of Saskatchewan

1948 –Dean of Ag, U of MB Wrote "Fifty Mighty Men" & "Power for Prairie Plows" Mayor of Calgary for 9 years
