A selection committee evaluates and reviews each submission and supporting documentation. The committee brings forth recommendations to the entire board where the final decision is reached.

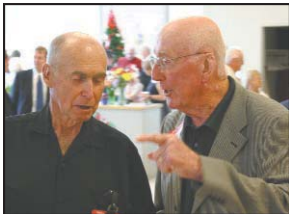
