**ALLAN CHAMBERS  
TREASURER**

Allan Chambers is in his second year on the Board of the Manitoba Agricultural Hall of Fame and is still learning the background on how the organization has evolved. His first and previous involvement with the Hall was to write a letter of support to the application for his 4-H leader of many years ago. Allan attended his first induction ceremony when Eric Trotter was inducted to the Hall in July of 2005.

When invited to join the Board of Directors, Allan was in the process of selling the remainder of his farm southeast of Arborg. He had long been interested in history in general and in the history of Manitoba agriculture. He agreed

to become a Board member of the Ag Hall of Fame as a way to continue making a small contribution to rural Manitoba after his retirement.

Allan served on the Finance Committee in his first year on the Board. This year he is chairing that committee and acting as Treasurer. An operating grant from the Province has been a significant part of the Hall's annual income. One of the goals of the rebranding initiative was to build the investment account to provide greater financial independence for the Ag Hall of Fame. Allan sees the main duty of the Finance Committee as supporting that objective, to monitor progress and to seek alternate approaches if needed.

Over the last year Allan has



learned much more about the Manitoba Agricultural Hall of Fame and about the many worthy inductees. He is pleased to do his part to recognize those individuals who have contributed to the development of rural Manitoba communities.

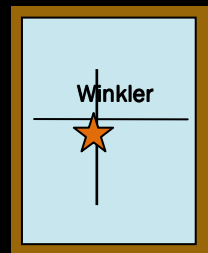
**"Andy" Anderson**
